They aim to bring people together through their food and music to learn about different cultures and the journeys they've made to the UK.

Guests of this upcoming event will have the chance to enjoy delicious food that is representative of Culture Kitchen cook's cultures from Africa, the Middle East and Europe. The lunch will be accompanied by presentations and music from refugee music organisation Crossings. Previous events have been met with rave reviews from guests. The event will be appropriate for all ages. People are asked to sign up in advance if they would like to attend so Culture Kitchen can gauge the right amount of food to buy in advance.
